Parent Questionnaire - March 2024 Results

Thank you to all the families who returned our recent survey. It was amazing to have an 87% return rate and certainly helps us to not only understand your views, but also find out ways that we can improve Arley Primary Academy.

We were all thrilled with the responses and the percentages below, especially how happy and safe the children feel and how so many parents and carers would recommend our fantastic school.

- My child is happy in school - **99% agreed or strongly agreed**
- My child does well at Arley - **98% agreed or strongly agreed**
- When I raised concerns with the school, they have been dealt with properly - **96% agreed or strongly agreed**
- I would recommend Arley to other parents - **95% agreed or strongly agreed**
- My child feels safe in school - **93% agreed or strongly agreed**
- When I raised concerns with the school, they have been dealt with properly – **91% agreed or strongly agreed**
- The school lets me know how my child is doing - **90% agreed or strongly agreed**
- There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school – **88% agreed or strongly agreed**
- The school has high expectations for my child – **83% agreed or strongly agreed**
- My child has SEND and the school gives me the support they need to succeed – **82% agreed or strongly agreed**

<i>The school makes me aware of what my child will learn over the year - 76% agreed or strongly agreed</i>	We have begun to send home termly curriculum letters which we hope will help to keep families more informed about what children are learning over the year. Class dojo and Tapestry (Early Years) keeping families informed
<i>My school makes sure its pupils behave well - 79% agreed or strongly agreed</i>	We are busy implementing our Relational Behaviour Policy and already seeing the vast impacts of this. All staff receive regular training on this and have support from the senior leaders. Children are learning about this too. We endeavor to keep improving this area of our school. We handle concerns appropriately (91% of families agree or strongly agreed)
